Students with I.E.P. or 504 plan may earn a local diploma through the compensatory option by compensating for a score of 45-54 on an exam with a score of 65+ on a different exam. Each score of 45-54 must be compensated by a separate score of 65 +. Minimum score of 55 (or successful appeal of 52-54) is required on the ELA Regents and one math Regents.
